## <u>AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1101</u> (First Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, insert "<u>EMERGENCY BILL</u>"; in the sponsor line, strike "**Senator Smith**" and substitute "<u>Senators Smith, Bailey, James, West,</u> <u>McKay, and Folden</u>"; strike line 2 in its entirety and substitute "<u>Higher Education</u> <u>– Maryland Police Officers and Probation Agents Scholarship Program –</u> <u>Alterations</u>"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 3 down through "II" in line 9 and substitute "<u>altering the definition of an eligible institution for the Maryland Police</u> <u>Officers and Probation Agents Scholarship Program to include a community college in</u> <u>the State</u>"; strike beginning with "police" in line 9 down through "scholarships" in line 10 and substitute "<u>the Maryland Police Officers and Probation Agents Scholarship</u> <u>Program</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 11 through 25, inclusive.

On page 2, in line 1, strike "18-101(a), (b), and (c)" and substitute " $\underline{18-3801(a)}$  and  $\underline{18-3802(a)}$  and (b)"; in line 6, strike "18-103" and substitute " $\underline{18-3801(b)}$ "; and strike in their entirety lines 9 through 20, inclusive.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 23 on page 2 through line 26 on page 3, inclusive.

On pages 3 through 11, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 28 on page 3 through line 17 on page 11, inclusive, and substitute:

(1) A public senior higher education institution in the State; OR

# (2) <u>A COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN THE STATE.</u>

<u>18–3802.</u>

(a) <u>There is a Maryland Police Officers and Probation Agents Scholarship</u> <u>Program.</u>

(b) The purpose of the program is to provide tuition assistance for students who are:

(1) Attending an eligible institution and enrolled in a degree program that would further the student's intent to become a police officer or probation agent after graduation; or

(2) <u>Employed as a police officer or probation agent, attending an eligible</u> <u>institution, and enrolled in a degree program that would further the police officer's or</u> <u>probation officer's career.</u>

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.".
