<u>AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 763</u> (Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, strike "<u>and Sunset</u>"; and strike beginning with "<u>terminating</u>" in line 7 down through "<u>date</u>" in line 8.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 8, after "<u>ARTICLE</u>" insert "<u>APPOINTED BY THE ATTORNEY</u> <u>GENERAL WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE</u>".

On page 3, strike beginning with "<u>(I)</u>" in line 10 down through "<u>THE</u>" in line 11 and substitute "<u>THE</u>"; in line 12, strike "2023" and substitute "<u>2024</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 13 through 15, inclusive.

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 16 and 17; in line 20, strike "<u>6–802(b)(1)</u> and (9)" and substitute "<u>6–802(b)</u>"; in lines 24 and 25, in each instance, strike "<u>five</u>" and substitute "<u>six</u>"; in line 25, strike "<u>and</u>"; in line 26, after "<u>2027</u>" insert "<u>; and</u>

(4) <u>seven members in 2028</u>";

after line 26, insert:

"<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That the terms of the members serving on the Commission on Hate Crimes Response and Prevention appointed under § 6–802(b) of the State Government Article as it existed on May 30, 2024, shall expire on June 1, 2024.";

in line 27, strike "3." and substitute "<u>4.</u>"; and in line 28, strike "October" and substitute "<u>June</u>".
