# AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 894

(First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Wivell" and substitute "Wivell, Alston, Cullison, Hill, Hutchinson, S. Johnson, Kaiser, Kerr, Pena-Melnyk, Reilly, and Rosenberg"; in line 2, strike "Government of the People's Republic of China" and substitute "Scrutinized Entities"; in line 4, strike "the People's Republic of China" and substitute "certain countries subject to an embargo under the International Traffic in Arms Regulations"; in line 12, strike "the government of the People's Republic of China" and substitute "scrutinized entities"; and in line 17, strike "Government of the People's Republic of China" and substitute "Procurement With Scrutinized Entities".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 23, strike "GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA" and substitute "PROCUREMENT WITH SCRUTINIZED ENTITIES".

On page 2, in line 11, strike "THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA" and substitute "A COUNTRY SUBJECT TO AN EMBARGO UNDER THE INTERNATIONAL TRAFFIC IN ARMS REGULATIONS AND LISTED UNDER 22 C.F.R 126.1(D)(1) OR (2)".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, after line 25, insert:

### "SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) This Act shall remain in effect until federal law no longer authorizes the states to adopt and enforce provisions of the type authorized under this Act.

(b) The Board of Public Works shall notify the Department of Legislative Services within 5 days after the federal government enacts a law described in subsection (a) of this section and, as of the date the law becomes effective, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.";

and in line 26, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
