AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1024

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "Public" insert "<u>Middle and High</u>"; in the same line, strike "Action Plan – Requirements" and substitute "<u>Response Plans for Athletic</u> Facilities

(The Bailey Bullock Act)";

in line 3, after "requiring" insert "<u>that</u>"; in the same line, after "public" insert "<u>middle and high</u>"; in the same line, strike "to develop and implement" and substitute "<u>alter the venue–specific emergency action plan for athletic facilities to incorporate</u>"; in line 4, strike "beginning on a certain date"; in lines 4 and 5, strike "a cardiac emergency action plan in public schools" and substitute "<u>cardiac emergency response plans for athletic facilities</u>"; and in line 8, strike "7–436" and substitute "<u>7–451</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 through 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 14 on page 1 through line 28 on page 3, inclusive.

On page 3, after line 28, insert:

"<u>7–451.</u>

- (a) (1) Each middle school and high school shall develop a venue—specific emergency action plan for all athletic facilities.
 - (2) A venue–specific emergency action plan includes:

- (i) The operation and use of automatic external defibrillators in accordance with § 7–425 of this subtitle;
- (ii) <u>Heat acclimatization in accordance with § 7–434 of this</u> subtitle; [and]
- (iii) Coordination of care for other emergent injuries, including cervical spinal injury, concussion and closed head injury, major orthopedic injuries, and severe weather for outdoor facilities; AND

(IV) A CARDIAC EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION.

- (b) A venue—specific emergency action plan developed under this section shall be:
 - (1) Posted at each athletic facility at the school;
- (2) Available on the school's website for viewing by a student athlete's parent or guardian at the beginning of each school year;
 - (3) Distributed to each member of the coaching staff; and
- (4) Rehearsed in person and interactively by all of the coaching staff of each sport before each of their respective seasons.
- (c) The provisions of a venue–specific emergency action plan for the operation and use of automatic external defibrillators shall ensure that:
- (1) An automated external defibrillator is provided on—site and is located at or within a brief walk from an athletic practice or event on school property;

- (2) An automated external defibrillator is freely accessible during all school functions;
- (3) All members of the coaching staff are trained in the operation and use of an automated external defibrillator; and
- (4) A trained member of the coaching staff is present at all athletic practices and events on school property.
- (d) The provisions of a venue–specific emergency action plan for heat acclimatization shall:
- (1) <u>Include guidelines for student athletes consistent with the Model</u> <u>Policy for Preseason–Practice Heat Acclimatization Guidelines for Student Athletes</u> established under § 7–434 of this subtitle;
- (2) Ensure that each school is properly prepared and equipped to initiate cold water immersion for the treatment of exertional heat stroke;
- (3) Ensure that the cooling modality is readily available to student athletes at all athletic practices and events on school property;
- (4) Ensure that all members of the coaching staff are trained in cold water immersion; and
- (5) Ensure that a trained member of the coaching staff is present at all athletic practices and events on school property.
- (E) (1) EACH VENUE-SPECIFIC EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN SHALL INCLUDE A CARDIAC EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN.";

and in line 29, after "A" insert "CARDIAC EMERGENCY RESPONSE".

On page 4, in line 1, after "PERSONNEL" insert "TO SERVE"; in lines 4 and 16, in each instance, strike "ON SCHOOL GROUNDS" and substitute "AT AN ATHLETIC FACILITY"; in line 5, strike "IDENTIFY AND COORDINATE" and substitute "COORDINATE"; in line 7, strike "ACTION" and substitute "RESPONSE"; strike beginning with "ESTABLISHMENT" in line 11 down through "2." in line 13; in line 16, after the semicolon insert "AND"; in line 17, strike "3." and substitute "2."; and strike beginning with "CARDIOPULMONARY" in line 18 down through the second "AND" in line 21 and substitute "TRAINING IN FIRST AID, CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR), AND THE OPERATION AND USE OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 7–425 OF THIS SUBTITLE, INCLUDING CARDIAC EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM MEMBERS, ATHLETIC COACHING AND TRAINING STAFF, SCHOOL NURSES, AND ANY OTHER INDIVIDUALS IDENTIFIED BY THE CARDIAC EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM.".

On pages 4 and 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 22 on page 4 through line 5 on page 5, inclusive.

On page 5, in line 6, strike "(4)" and substitute "(3)"; in the same line, strike "PUBLIC" and substitute "YEAR, EACH MIDDLE SCHOOL AND HIGH"; in line 7, strike "ACTION PLAN EACH YEAR" and substitute "RESPONSE PLAN REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION"; and strike in their entirety lines 8 through 10, inclusive.
