# <u>AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 565</u> (First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike line 2 in its entirety and substitute "<u>Correctional Services</u> – <u>Investigation of Suspected Homicide – Reporting</u>"; strike beginning with "establishing" in line 3 down through "Board." in line 8 and substitute "<u>requiring the</u> <u>Department of State Police to post certain information relating to certain investigations</u> <u>of deaths of incarcerated individuals on its website; requiring the Department to report</u> <u>to the Governor and the General Assembly on certain investigations; and generally</u> <u>relating to investigations of deaths of incarcerated individuals.</u>"; in line 9, strike "adding to" and substitute "<u>repealing and reenacting, with amendments</u>,"; in line 10, strike "State Government" and substitute "<u>Correctional Services</u>"; strike beginning with "9– 3801" in line 11 down through "Board"" in line 12 and substitute "<u>9–602.1</u>"; and in line 14, strike "(2021" and substitute "<u>(2017</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 through 7, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 17 on page 1 through line 17 on page 7, inclusive, and substitute:

# "Article - Correctional Services

#### 9-602.1.

(A) The Department of State Police shall investigate any death of an incarcerated individual suspected to be a homicide that occurs while the incarcerated individual is in the custody of the Division of Correction whether within or outside a correctional facility.

# (B) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE SHALL POST ON ITS WEBSITE AND SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR

(1) THE NUMBER OF INVESTIGATIONS COMPLETED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

(2) THE NUMBER OF CASES REFERRED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE FOR PROSECUTION FOLLOWING AN INVESTIGATION COMPLETED UNDER THIS SECTION.".
