#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

Morgan, Pena-Melnyk, Reilly, Rosenberg, Szeliga, Taveras, White Holland, and Woods"; and in line 7, after "Physicians;" insert "prohibiting an individual from practicing as a supervised medical graduate for more than a certain period of time;".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, in line 11, strike "AND"; in line 12, strike "PRESENCE OF" and substitute "<u>SAME MEDICAL OFFICE AS</u>"; in line 13, after "GRADUATE" insert "<u>; AND</u>

# <u>3.</u> <u>IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE TO PROVIDE</u> <u>ASSISTANCE AND GUIDANCE TO THE SUPERVISED MEDICAL GRADUATE FOR THE</u> <u>DURATION OF THE COMPLETION OF A DELEGATED DUTY</u>";

in line 26, strike "IN" and substitute "<u>SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS</u> <u>SUBSECTION AND IN</u>"; and after line 28, insert:

## "(3) <u>AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT PRACTICE AS A SUPERVISED</u> MEDICAL GRADUATE FOR A PERIOD OF MORE THAN 2 YEARS.

(4) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, A DELEGATING PHYSICIAN IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE IN THE PRESENCE OF A PATIENT AND A SUPERVISED MEDICAL GRADUATE DURING THE COMPLETION OF A DELEGATED DUTY.".
