### <u>AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 837</u> (First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Pasteur" and substitute "<u>Pasteur</u>, <u>Attar, Atterbeary, Ebersole, Fair, Feldmark, Griffith, Grossman, Henson, R.</u> <u>Long, Miller, Mireku–North, Palakovich Carr, Patterson, Roberts, Vogel, Wells, Wilkins, Wims, and Young</u>"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 3 down through "employers;" in line 7; strike beginning with "pay" in line 9 down through "circumstances" in line 10 and substitute "<u>assist public high schools in a certain task</u>"; in line 11, strike "and apprenticeships" and substitute "<u>opportunities</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 17 through 21, inclusive.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with "**IN**" in line 2 down through "**(C)**" in line 18; in line 24, strike the second "**AND**"; and in line 26, after "**BOARDS**" insert "<u>; AND</u>

## (3) <u>SCHOOLS LICENSED BY THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION</u> <u>COMMISSION THAT PROVIDE TRAINING, RETRAINING, OR ENHANCEMENT IN</u> <u>EMPLOYMENT SKILLS.</u>

## (C) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL ASSIST PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS IN COMPLETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION".
