AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1027 (Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, strike "EMERGENCY BILL"; strike line 2 in its entirety and substitute "**Property Tax – Appeals – Definition of "Taxpayer" and Fee**"; strike beginning with "to" in line 4 down through "appeal" in line 5; in line 5, after the semicolon insert "requiring certain persons who appeal the value or classification of commercial real property to pay a fee to the supervisor of assessments at the time of filing the appeal;"; in line 6, strike "retroactively" and substitute "prospectively"; and after line 11, insert:

"<u>BY adding to</u>

<u>Article - Tax - Property</u> <u>Section 14-501.1</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2019 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 7, after "MEANS" insert ":

(1) FOR PURPOSES OF AN APPEAL REGARDING ANY PROPERTY OTHER THAN COMMERCIAL REAL PROPERTY,";

in the same line, after "**PERSON**" insert "<u>, OR AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF</u> <u>A PERSON</u>,"; in line 8, strike "A" and substitute "<u>THE</u>"; in the same line, strike "AN" and substitute "<u>THE</u>"; in line 9, after "APPEAL" insert "<u>; AND</u>

(2) FOR PURPOSES OF AN APPEAL REGARDING COMMERCIAL REAL PROPERTY, ANY TAXPAYER, INCLUDING A TAXPAYER WHO DOES NOT HAVE AN

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<u>OWNERSHIP INTEREST OR A LEASEHOLD INTEREST IN THE REAL PROPERTY THAT</u> <u>IS SUBJECT TO THE APPEAL</u>";

and after line 9, insert:

"<u>14–501.1.</u>

(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A PERSON WHO:

(1) <u>APPEALS THE VALUE OR CLASSIFICATION OF COMMERCIAL</u> <u>REAL PROPERTY;</u>

(2) <u>DOES NOT HAVE AN OWNERSHIP INTEREST OR A LEASEHOLD</u> INTEREST IN THE PROPERTY THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE APPEAL; AND

(3) IS NOT AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF A PERSON WHO HAS AN OWNERSHIP INTEREST OR A LEASEHOLD INTEREST IN THE PROPERTY THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE APPEAL.

(B) <u>A PERSON SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PAY A FEE OF \$100 TO</u> <u>THE SUPERVISOR AT THE TIME THE PERSON FILES AN APPEAL OF THE VALUE OR</u> <u>CLASSIFICATION OF COMMERCIAL REAL PROPERTY.</u>

(C) THE SUPERVISOR SHALL DEPOSIT THE FEE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION IN THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.".

On pages 2 and 3, strike beginning with "retroactively" in line 31 on page 2 down through "refunded" in line 2 on page 3 and substitute "<u>only prospectively and may not</u> <u>be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any:</u>

(1) petition for review of an assessment of property that is filed before the effective date of this Act; or

(2) subsequent appeal resulting from a petition for review of an assessment of property that is filed before the effective date of this Act".

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On page 3, strike beginning with "is" in line 3 down through "enacted" in line 7 and substitute "<u>shall take effect July 1, 2024</u>".
