## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "Delegate Embry" and substitute "Delegates Embry, Crutchfield, Cardin, Pasteur, Toles, Phillips, Arikan, Taylor, Simpson, Grammer, Conaway, Kaufman, and Williams".

AMENDMENT NO. 2
On page 1, strike beginning with "adding" in line 3 down through "required" in line 6 and substitute "altering the definition of "abuse" to include labor trafficking of a child by any individual for purposes of provisions of law governing children in need of assistance cases and child abuse and neglect reporting"; in line 12 , strike "and 3-812"; and in line 22 , strike " $5-701(\mathrm{~m})$ " and substitute " $\underline{5-701(\mathrm{~b}) \text { and (m)". }}$

## AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2 , in line 10 , strike "or"; and in line 15, after "member" insert "; OR

## (3) LABOR TRAFFICKING OF A CHILD BY ANY INDIVIDUAL".

On pages 7 through 9 , strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 7 on page 7 through line 13 on page 9 , inclusive.

On page 9, after line 17, insert:
"(b) (1) "Abuse" means:
(i) the physical or mental injury of a child under circumstances that indicate that the child's health or welfare is harmed or at substantial risk of being harmed by:

1. a parent:
2. a household member or family member;
3. a person who has permanent or temporary care or
custody of the child;
4. a person who has responsibility for supervision of the
child; or

(ii) sexual abuse of a child, whether physical injuries are sustained or not; OR
(III) LABOR TRAFFICKING OF A CHILD BY ANY INDIVIDUAL.
(2) "Abuse" does not include the physical injury of a child by accidental means.".
