AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 119
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, after “care;” insert “prohibiting a qualified provider from providing to a minor gender-affirming treatment that involves surgery;”.

On page 2, after line 2, insert:

“BY adding to

Article - Health - General

Section 20-2401 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 24. Surgical Gender-
Affirming Treatment”

Annotated Code of Maryland
(2023 Replacement Volume)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, after line 19, insert:

“SUBTITLE 24. SURGICAL GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT.

20-2401.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, “QUALIFIED PROVIDER” MEANS A PHYSICIAN, PRACTITIONER, PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT, OR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL:

(1) WHO IS LICENSED, CERTIFIED, OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO PRACTICE IN THE STATE; AND

(2) FROM WHOM THE PROVISION OF GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT, AS DEFINED IN § 15-151 OF THIS ARTICLE, IS WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S LICENSE OR CERTIFICATION.

(B) A QUALIFIED PROVIDER MAY NOT PROVIDE TO A MINOR GENDER-AFFIRMING TREATMENT THAT INVOLVES SURGERY."
