BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Public Safety 3–113.1. AT ANY TIME BEFORE A HEARING IS HELD BY THE HEARING BOARD UNDER § 3-106 OF THIS SUBTITLE, A POLICE OFFICER WHO IS DENIED A RIGHT GRANTED BY THIS SUBTITLE MAY APPLY TO THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR AN ORDER THAT DIRECTS THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY TO SHOW CAUSE WHY THE RIGHT SHOULD NOT BE GRANTED.
