16 17 18	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "SEXUALLY EXPLICIT MATERIALS" MEANS BOOKS AND AUDITORY AND VISUAL MATERIALS THAT CONTAIN GRAPHIC OR OBSCENE DEPICTIONS OF SEXUAL ACTIVITY THAT ARE NOT:
19	(1) AGE-APPROPRIATE; OR
20	(2) USED AS PART OF THE APPROVED INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

- 5 (C) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL ADOPT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES TO 6 IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 8 1, 2024.
