SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

15 (a) The operator of a motorcycle may ride the motorcycle only on the permanent 16 and regular seat attached to it.

17 (b) The operator of a motorcycle may not carry any other person unless the 18 motorcycle is designed to carry more than one person, in which event a passenger may ride

3 (c) (1) A person other than the operator of a motorcycle may not ride on a 4 motorcycle unless the motorcycle is designed to carry more than one person, in which event 5 a passenger may ride on the permanent and regular seat, if designed for [2] TWO persons, 6 or on another seat firmly attached to the motorcycle at the rear or side of the operator.

7 (2) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS 8 PARAGRAPH, A PASSENGER MAY NOT RIDE ON A MOTORCYCLE ON A SEAT AT THE 9 REAR OF THE OPERATOR UNLESS THE PASSENGER IS ABLE TO POSITION THE 10 PASSENGER'S FEET FIRMLY ON THE FOOTRESTS WHILE SEATED.

11 (II) SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY 12 TO A PASSENGER ON A MOTORCYCLE WHO IS UNABLE TO POSITION THE 13 PASSENGER'S FEET FIRMLY ON THE FOOTRESTS DUE TO A PERMANENT PHYSICAL 14 DISABILITY.

15 (d) A person may ride on a motorcycle operated under a Class M driver's license 16 only while sitting astride the seat, facing forward, with one leg on each side of the 17 motorcycle.

18 (e) A person may not operate a motorcycle while carrying any package, bundle, 19 or other article that prevents the person from keeping both hands on the steering 20 mechanism.

21 (f) The operator of a motorcycle may not carry any person in a position that 22 interferes with the operation or control of the motorcycle or the view of the operator.

23 (g) A person other than the operator of a motorcycle may not ride in a position 24 that interferes with the operation or control of the motorcycle or the view of the operator.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2024.
