BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Labor and Employment Section 3-1304(a)(1)Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Labor and Employment 3-1304. Subject to subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph, an employer that employs 15 or more employees shall provide an employee with earned sick and safe leave that is paid at the same wage rate as the employee normally earns. An employer that employs 14 or fewer employees shall at least provide an employee with unpaid earned sick and safe leave. An employer may not be required to pay a tipped employee more (iii) than the applicable minimum wage for earned sick and safe leave.
