- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 14
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A LOCAL JURISDICTION WITH AT LEAST **250,000** RESIDENTS. 19
- 20 ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1 EACH YEAR, EACH LOCAL JURISDICTION (B)
- SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION SHALL REPORT TO THE 21
- 22DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND
- DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR EACH TYPE OF 23

- 7 (4) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF RESIDENTIAL UNITS APPROVED;
- 8 **(5)** THE MEAN AND MEDIAN PROCESSING TIMES FOR PERMIT 9 APPLICATIONS AND THE STANDARD DEVIATION FROM THE MEAN;
- 10 (6) ANY TYPE OF EXPEDITED PERMIT APPLICATION PROCESS THAT
- 11 THE LOCAL JURISDICTION EMPLOYED TO ACCELERATE RESIDENTIAL HOUSING

- 19 (II) AN ANNOUNCEMENT POSTED TO A LOCAL JURISDICTION'S
- 20 WEBSITE STATING THAT A PERSON SHOULD CONTACT THE RELEVANT LOCAL
- 21 DEPARTMENT FOR ACCESS TO THE REPORT DOES NOT FULFILL THE REQUIREMENTS
- 22 OF SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.
- 23 (2) A LOCAL JURISDICTION THAT DOES NOT MAINTAIN A WEBSITE
- 24 SHALL MAKE THE REPORT PUBLICLY AVAILABLE THROUGH ANY OTHER
- 25 REASONABLE METHOD.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 October 1, 2024.
