BY adding to Article – Land Use Section 7–105 Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Volume and 2023 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Land Use 7-105. (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A LOCAL JURISDICTION WITH AT LEAST
