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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Commission to Study African American Civil War Soldiers in Maryland**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Commission to Study African American Civil War  
4 Soldiers in Maryland to study the history of the African American soldiers who  
5 fought for the Union Army and make certain recommendations regarding a memorial  
6 dedicated to African American Civil War soldiers; and generally relating to the  
7 Commission to Study African American Civil War Soldiers in Maryland.

8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
9 That:

10 (a) There is a Commission to Study African American Civil War Soldiers in  
11 Maryland.

12 (b) The Commission consists of the following members:

13 (1) one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of  
14 the Senate;

15 (2) one member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the  
16 House; and

17 (3) the following members, appointed by the Governor:

18 (i) one representative from the State Archives;

19 (ii) one representative from the Department of Planning;

20 (iii) one representative from the Governor's Commission on  
21 Maryland Military Monuments;

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EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (iv) one representative from the Commission on African American  
2 History and Culture;

3 (v) one representative from Preservation Maryland, Inc.; and

4 (vi) one representative from the Heart of the Civil War Heritage  
5 Area, Inc.

6 (c) The Governor shall designate the chair of the Commission.

7 (d) The State Archives shall provide staff for the Commission.

8 (e) A member of the Commission:

9 (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Commission; but

10 (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State  
11 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

12 (f) The Commission shall:

13 (1) study the history of African American Civil War soldiers who fought for  
14 the Union Army in Maryland, including muster rolls, locations of service, and all  
15 distinguished honors and recognitions awarded; and

16 (2) make findings and recommendations regarding the funding, design,  
17 construction, and location of an appropriate memorial dedicated to the African American  
18 Civil War soldiers in Maryland.

19 (g) On or before December 1, 2024, the Commission shall report its findings and  
20 recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State  
21 Government Article, the General Assembly.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
23 1, 2024. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 2025, this  
24 Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no  
25 further force and effect.
