23 (a) A credit under this section shall be applied to an applicant's score on any selection test administered to establish placement on a list of eligible candidates for which

- the applicant otherwise is qualified and has at least the minimum passing score on a 1 2selection test. 3 In this subsection[, "eligible veteran"] THE FOLLOWING WORDS (c) (1) **(I)** HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED. 4 "ACTIVE DUTY SPOUSE" MEANS THE SPOUSE OF AN ACTIVE 5 (II)DUTY SERVICE MEMBER OF ANY BRANCH OF THE UNIFORMED SERVICES WHO IS 6 7 RELOCATING TO THE STATE ON MILITARY ORDERS. 8 (III) "ELIGIBLE VETERAN" means a veteran of any branch of the [armed forces of the United States] UNIFORMED SERVICES who has received an honorable 9 discharge or a certificate of satisfactory completion of military service, including the 10 National Guard and the military reserves. 11 (IV) "UNIFORMED SERVICES" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 12 9-1104 OF THIS ARTICLE. 13 14 (2)An appointing authority shall apply a credit of ten points on any (i) 15 selection test for: 16 1. an eligible veteran; 17 2.the spouse of an eligible veteran who has a service 18 connected disability; [or] the surviving spouse of a deceased eligible veteran; OR 19 3. 204. - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
