SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

 each list submitted to the Secretary and the Governor under this paragraph shall be three
 times the number of vacancies.
- 10(4)For each pharmacist vacancy and each registered pharmacy technician11vacancy:
- 12 (i) The Board shall notify all licensed pharmacists, registered 13 pharmacy technicians, and other interested parties of record in the State of the vacancy to 14 solicit nominations to fill the vacancy and provide information for contacting a 15 representative of the group that submits the list of names to the Governor under paragraph 16 (3) of this subsection; and
- 17 (ii) Except for the at-large vacancies, each association that is 18 responsible for submitting a list of nominees to the Secretary and the Governor under this 19 section shall:
- I. Issue a nomination form upon the request of any licensed
 pharmacist and consider all nominations received by the association's deadline;
- 22 2. Form a committee, which recognizes diversity within the 23 State in geographic distribution, sex, race, and age, comprised of at least five pharmacists 24 to review nominations, interview all qualified nominees in a meeting open to the public, 25 and select three names for each vacancy to be submitted to the Secretary and the Governor; 26 and
- 3. In the event that fewer than three qualified nominees are
 submitted to the association, select any additional names that are needed to complete the
 list required to be submitted to the Secretary and the Governor under this section.
- 30 (5) The Governor shall appoint the consumer members with the advice of 31 the Secretary and the advice and consent of the Senate.
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- (6) Each member of the Board shall be a resident of this State.

33 (7) A member of the Board shall be recused from all aspects of the licensing
 34 exam if that Board member:

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(i) Is a member of the board of trustees at a school of pharmacy;

1 Is a teacher at a school of pharmacy; or (ii) $\mathbf{2}$ (iii) Acquires the member's primary source of income through 3 employment by a school of pharmacy. 4 (b)Each pharmacist member and each registered pharmacy technician member of the Board shall: $\mathbf{5}$ 6 (1)Be skilled and competent in practicing pharmacy; and 7 (2)Have at least 5 years of active pharmacy practice. Each consumer member of the Board: 8 (c) Shall be a member of the general public; 9 (1)10 (2)May not be or ever have been a pharmacist or in training to become a pharmacist: 11 12May not have a household member who is a pharmacist or in training (3)13to become a pharmacist; 14 May not participate or ever have participated in a commercial or (4)15professional field related to practicing pharmacy; 16 May not have a household member who participates in a commercial or (5)17professional field related to practicing pharmacy; and 18 (6)May not have had within 2 years before appointment a substantial 19financial interest in a person regulated by the Board. 20While a member of the Board, a consumer member may not have a substantial (d) financial interest in a person regulated by the Board. 2122(e) Before taking office, each appointee to the Board shall take the oath required by Article I, § 9 of the Maryland Constitution. 2324(f) (1)The term of a member is 4 years. 25(2)The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Board on July 1, 1981. 2627(3)At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is 28appointed and qualifies.

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1 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the 2 rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

3 (5) To the extent practicable, the Governor shall fill any vacancy on the 4 Board within 60 days of the date of the vacancy.

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(6) A member may not serve more than 2 consecutive full terms.

6 (g) (1) The Governor may remove a member for incompetence or misconduct.

7 (2) Upon the recommendation of the Secretary, the Governor may remove 8 a member whom the Secretary finds to have been absent from 2 successive Board meetings 9 without adequate reason.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2024.
