BY adding to Article - State Finance and Procurement Section 2–901 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 9. Collection of Yard Waste" Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - State Finance and Procurement SUBTITLE 9. COLLECTION OF YARD WASTE. 2-901.
