2 (A) THE OWNER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE, OR A LESSEE OF THE VEHICLE 3 UNDER A LEASE NOT INTENDED AS SECURITY, MAY APPLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION 4 FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF SPECIAL DISABLED VETERAN REGISTRATION PLATES 5 UNDER THIS SECTION FOR A VEHICLE INCLUDED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING 6 CLASSES:

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(1) A CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE;
