4 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Amusement Ride Safety Advisory Board in  
5 accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset law)  
6 by ~~extending to a certain date~~ ~~repealing~~ extending to a certain date the termination  
7 provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Board; requiring  
8 the Maryland Department of Labor to submit a certain report to the Joint Audit and  
9 Evaluation Committee on or before a certain date; and generally relating to the State  
10 Amusement Ride Safety Advisory Board.

8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

14 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program

16 1, [2024] 2027.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before July 1, 2025, the  
18 Maryland Department of Labor shall submit a report to the Joint Audit and Evaluation  
19 Committee with information regarding the State Amusement Ride Safety Advisory Board  
20 as determined by the Joint Audit and Evaluation Committee.
