Cannabis Licensing and Registration – Use of Straw Ownership – Prohibition

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from applying for or holding a cannabis license or registration under certain circumstances if an ownership interest in the license or registration is for the limited purpose of satisfying certain requirements of registration or licensure; requiring the Maryland Cannabis Administration to deny a certain application or revoke a cannabis license or registration if the applicant, licensee, or registrant is convicted of a violation of this Act; and generally relating to straw ownership and cannabis licensing and registration.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis

- 19 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT APPLY FOR OR HOLD A CANNABIS LICENSE OR
- 20 REGISTRATION UNDER THIS TITLE IF AN OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN THE LICENSE OR
- 21 REGISTRATION IS:
- 22 (1) NOMINAL OR WITHOUT THE BENEFITS AND RISKS OF GENUINE
- 23 OWNERSHIP; AND

- 1 (2) FOR THE LIMITED PURPOSE OF SATISFYING THE REQUIREMENTS
 2 UNDER THIS TITLE FOR CANNABIS LICENSEES OR REGISTRANTS, INCLUDING
 3 REQUIREMENTS FOR SOCIAL EQUITY LICENSEES OR REGISTRANTS.
- 4 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY 5 OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN 6 \$2,500 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR BOTH.
- 7 (C) SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 36–202 OF THIS TITLE, THE
 8 ADMINISTRATION SHALL DENY AN APPLICATION FOR A CANNABIS LICENSE OR
 9 REGISTRATION OR REVOKE A CANNABIS LICENSE OR REGISTRATION UNDER THIS
 10 TITLE IF THE APPLICANT, CANNABIS LICENSEE, OR REGISTRANT IS CONVICTED OF
 11 VIOLATING SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
