### CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Alcoholic Beverages – B–D–7 Licenses – Hours of Sale**

3 FOR the purpose of altering a geographic boundary in the 45th alcoholic beverages district  
4 of Baltimore City within which the holder of a B–D–7 beer, wine, and liquor license  
5 must operate in accordance with specified hours; and generally relating to alcoholic  
6 beverages in Baltimore City.

4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
 5 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

7 12–102.

8 This title applies only in Baltimore City.

9 12–2004.

10 (c) A holder of a Class B–D–7 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine,  
 11 and liquor:

12 (1) from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. in the area bounded by Liberty Heights Avenue,  
 13 Northern Parkway, Druid Park Drive, and Wabash Avenue;

14 (2) from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. along the south side of Frederick Avenue between  
 15 South Augusta Avenue and South Loudon Avenue;

16 (3) from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. in the area specified in the Park Heights Master  
 17 Plan adopted by the City in 2006;

18 (4) from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. in an area bounded [on the north by North  
 19 Avenue, on the west by Central Avenue and Harford Avenue, on the south by Monument  
 20 Street as it runs from North Central Avenue to North Wolfe Street and McElderry Street  
 21 as it runs from North Wolfe Street to Luzerne Avenue, and on the east by Luzerne Avenue  
 22 as it runs from Monument Street to Federal Street, then by Rose Street as it runs from  
 23 Federal Street to North Avenue] **AS FOLLOWS: FROM THE INTERSECTION OF EAST  
 24 NORTH AVENUE AND HARFORD AVENUE, SOUTHWEST ON HARFORD AVENUE TO  
 25 THE INTERSECTION OF HARFORD AVENUE AND NORTH CENTRAL AVENUE, SOUTH  
 26 ON NORTH CENTRAL AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH EAST MONUMENT  
 27 STREET, EAST ON EAST MONUMENT STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF EAST  
 28 MONUMENT STREET AND NORTH WOLFE STREET, SOUTH ON NORTH WOLFE  
 29 STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH WOLFE STREET AND MCELDERRY  
 30 STREET, EAST ON MCELDERRY STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF MCELDERRY  
 31 STREET AND NORTH MONTFORD AVENUE, SOUTH ON NORTH MONTFORD AVENUE  
 32 TO THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH MONTFORD AVENUE AND ORLEANS STREET,  
 33 EAST ON ORLEANS STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF ORLEANS STREET  
 34 COLLINGTON AVENUE, SOUTH ON NORTH COLLINGTON AVENUE TO THE  
 35 INTERSECTION OF NORTH COLLINGTON AVENUE AND EAST FAYETTE STREET, EAST**

1 ***ON EAST FAYETTE STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF EAST FAYETTE STREET AND***  
 2 ***NORTH LAKEWOOD AVENUE, NORTH ON NORTH LAKEWOOD AVENUE TO THE***  
 3 ***INTERSECTION OF NORTH LAKEWOOD AVENUE AND EAST MONUMENT STREET,***  
 4 ***WEST ON EAST MONUMENT STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF EAST MONUMENT***  
 5 ***STREET AND NORTH LUZERNE AVENUE, NORTH ON NORTH LUZERNE AVENUE TO***  
 6 ***THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH LUZERNE AVENUE AND EAST FEDERAL STREET,***  
 7 ***WEST ON EAST FEDERAL STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF EAST FEDERAL***  
 8 ***STREET AND NORTH ROSE STREET, NORTH ON NORTH ROSE STREET TO THE***  
 9 ***INTERSECTION OF NORTH ROSE STREET AND EAST NORTH AVENUE, THEN WEST***  
 10 ***ON EAST NORTH AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF EAST NORTH AVENUE AND***  
 11 ***HARFORD AVENUE; and***

12 (5) from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in all other locations in the City.  
 13 12–2005.

14 (c) (1) This subsection does not apply to:

- 15 (i) a Class B beer and light wine license;
- 16 (ii) a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license;
- 17 (iii) a Class B–D–7 beer, wine, and liquor license;
- 18 (iv) a Class C beer and light wine license; and
- 19 (v) a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license.

20 (2) For a license holder in an area bounded by Liberty Heights Avenue,  
 21 Northern Parkway, Druid Park Drive, and Wabash Avenue, the hours of sale:

- 22 (i) may not begin before 9 a.m. or end after 10 p.m.; and
- 23 (ii) may not be extended if they begin later than 9 a.m. or end before  
 24 10 p.m.

25 (3) For a license holder in an area bounded [on the north by North Avenue,  
 26 on the west by Central Avenue and Harford Avenue, on the south by Monument Street as  
 27 it runs from North Central Avenue to North Wolfe Street and McElderry Street as it runs  
 28 from North Wolfe Street to Luzerne Avenue, and on the east by Luzerne Avenue as it runs  
 29 from Monument Street to Federal Street, then by Rose Street as it runs from Federal Street  
 30 to North Avenue] **AS FOLLOWS: FROM THE INTERSECTION OF EAST NORTH AVENUE**  
 31 **AND HARFORD AVENUE, SOUTHWEST ON HARFORD AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION**  
 32 **OF HARFORD AVENUE AND NORTH CENTRAL AVENUE, SOUTH ON NORTH CENTRAL**  
 33 **AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH EAST MONUMENT STREET, EAST ON EAST**

1 MONUMENT STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF EAST MONUMENT STREET AND  
 2 NORTH WOLFE STREET, SOUTH ON NORTH WOLFE STREET TO THE INTERSECTION  
 3 OF NORTH WOLFE STREET AND McELDERRY STREET, EAST ON McELDERRY  
 4 STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF McELDERRY STREET AND NORTH ~~MONTFORD~~  
 5 ~~AVENUE, SOUTH ON NORTH MONTFORD AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH~~  
 6 ~~MONTFORD AVENUE AND ORLEANS STREET, EAST ON ORLEANS STREET TO THE~~  
 7 ~~INTERSECTION OF ORLEANS STREET~~ COLLINGTON AVENUE, SOUTH ON NORTH  
 8 COLLINGTON AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH COLLINGTON AVENUE  
 9 AND EAST FAYETTE STREET, EAST ON EAST FAYETTE STREET TO THE  
 10 INTERSECTION OF EAST FAYETTE STREET AND NORTH LAKEWOOD AVENUE,  
 11 NORTH ON NORTH LAKEWOOD AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH  
 12 LAKEWOOD AVENUE AND EAST MONUMENT STREET, WEST ON EAST MONUMENT  
 13 STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF EAST MONUMENT STREET AND NORTH  
 14 LUZERNE AVENUE, NORTH ON NORTH LUZERNE AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF  
 15 NORTH LUZERNE AVENUE AND EAST FEDERAL STREET, WEST ON EAST FEDERAL  
 16 STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF EAST FEDERAL STREET AND NORTH ROSE  
 17 STREET, NORTH ON NORTH ROSE STREET TO THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH ROSE  
 18 STREET AND EAST NORTH AVENUE, THEN WEST ON EAST NORTH AVENUE TO THE  
 19 INTERSECTION OF EAST NORTH AVENUE AND HARFORD AVENUE, the hours of sale:

- 20 (i) may not begin before 9 a.m. or end after 10 p.m.; and  
 21 (ii) may not be extended if they begin later than 9 a.m. or end before  
 22 10 p.m.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June  
 24 1, 2024.
