- FOR the purpose of providing that certain provisions requiring prompt payments for State procurement contracts apply to payments owed by a contractor or subcontractor to a supplier; and generally relating to the prompt payment of suppliers that have supplied labor or materials for work done under State procurement contracts.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

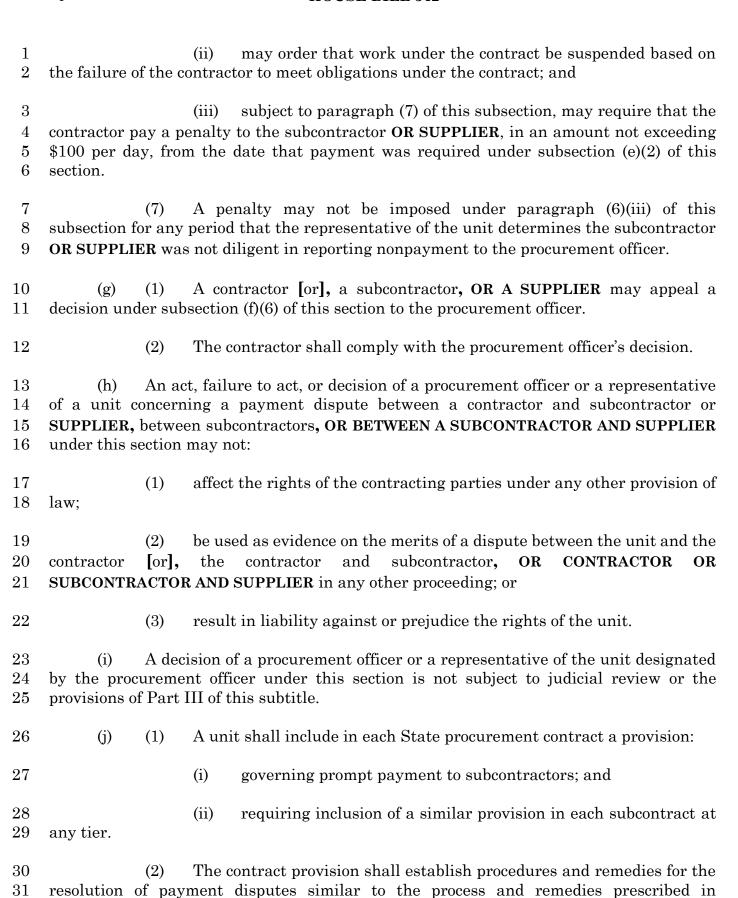

- 16 (a) **(1)** In this section[, "undisputed] **THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE** 17 **MEANINGS INDICATED.**
- 18 (2) "SUPPLIER" MEANS A PERSON THAT HAS SUPPLIED LABOR OR 19 MATERIALS TO A CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR IN THE PROSECUTION OF
- 20 WORK PROVIDED FOR IN A STATE PROCUREMENT CONTRACT.
- 21 **(3) "UNDISPUTED** amount" means an amount owed by a contractor to a subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** for which there is no good faith dispute, including any
- 23 retainage withheld.

1 (b) It is the policy of the State that, for work under a State procurement contract: 2 a contractor shall promptly pay to a subcontractor OR SUPPLIER any 3 undisputed amount to which the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** is entitled; and 4 a subcontractor shall promptly pay to a lower tier subcontractor OR (2)5 **SUPPLIER** any undisputed amount to which the lower tier subcontractor is entitled. 6 A contractor shall pay a subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** an undisputed (c) (1) 7 amount to which the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** is entitled within 10 days of receiving a progress or final payment from the State. 8 9 If a contractor withholds payment from a subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER**, (2)10 within the time period in which payment normally would be made, the contractor shall: notify the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER in writing and state the 11 (i) 12 reason why payment is being withheld; and 13 (ii) provide a copy of the notice to the procurement officer. 14 (d) If a subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** does not receive a payment within the (1) 15 required time period, the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER may give written notice of the nonpayment to the procurement officer. 16 17 (2)The notice shall: 18 indicate the name of the contractor, the project under which the (i) dispute exists, and the amount in dispute; 19 20 (ii) provide an itemized description on which the amount is based; 21and 22 if known, provide an explanation for any dispute concerning (iii) 23 payment by the contractor. 24Within 2 business days of receipt of written notice from a subcontractor (e) (1) 25**OR SUPPLIER**, a representative of the unit designated by the procurement officer shall 26 verbally contact the contractor to ascertain whether the amount withheld is an undisputed 27 amount. 28(2)If the representative of the unit decides that a part or all of the amount 29 withheld is an undisputed amount, the representative of the unit shall instruct the contractor to pay the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER the undisputed amount within 3 30 31 business days.

- 1 The representative of the unit shall verbally communicate to the (3) 2 subcontractor OR SUPPLIER the results of discussions with the contractor. 3 If the contractor is instructed to pay the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER 4 and the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER is not paid within the time instructed under 5 paragraph (2) of this subsection, the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER may report the 6 nonpayment in writing to the procurement officer. 7 (f) If the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER notifies the procurement officer (1) 8 under subsection (e)(4) of this section that payment has not been made, the representative 9 of the unit shall schedule a meeting to discuss the dispute with the unit's project manager, the contractor, and the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER: 10 11 (i) at a time and location designated by the representative of the 12 unit; but 13 (ii) not later than 10 days after receiving notice from the 14 subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** under subsection (e)(4) of this section. 15 (2)The purpose of the meeting is to establish why the contractor has not 16 paid the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** in the required time period. 17 The representative of the unit shall require the parties to provide at the (3)18 meeting any information that the representative believes necessary to evaluate the dispute. 19 (4) If the representative of the unit determines that the contractor is 20 delinquent in payment of an undisputed amount to the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER, 21further progress payments to the contractor may be withheld until the subcontractor OR 22**SUPPLIER** is paid. 23If payment is not paid to the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER within 7 days (5)24after the representative of the unit determines that the contractor is delinquent in paying the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER under this subsection, the representative shall schedule 2526 a second meeting to address the dispute: 27 (i) at a time and location designated by the representative of the 28 unit; but 29 (ii) not later than 5 days after the close of the 7-day period. 30 If, at the completion of the second meeting, the representative of the unit determines that the contractor continues to be delinquent in payments owed to the 31 32 subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER**, the representative:
- 33 (i) shall order that further payments to the contractor not be 34 processed until payment to the subcontractor is verified;

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subsections (c) through (g) of this section.



SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
