3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
4 1, 2024. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2026,
5 this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and
