19 (A) ON THE FILING OF A PETITION FOR GUARDIANSHIP OF THE PROPERTY 20 OF AN ALLEGED DISABLED PERSON, THERE SHALL BE AN AUTOMATIC STAY ON THE 21COMMENCEMENT OR CONTINUATION OF THE FOLLOWING CIVIL ACTIONS OR 22 PROCEEDINGS AGAINST THE ALLEGED DISABLED PERSON:



- 1 (1) AN ACTION FOR FAILURE TO PAY RENT UNDER § 8–401 OF THE 2 REAL PROPERTY ARTICLE;
- 3 (2) A WARRANT OF RESTITUTION UNDER § 8–401 OF THE REAL 4 PROPERTY ARTICLE;
- 5 (3) AN ACTION FOR WRONGFUL DETAINER UNDER § 14–132 OF THE 6 REAL PROPERTY ARTICLE;
- 7 (4) A FORECLOSURE ACTION UNDER § 7–105.1 OF THE REAL 8 PROPERTY ARTICLE;
- 9 (5) A SHERIFF'S SALE UNDER TITLE 11, SUBTITLE 5 OF THE COURTS 10 ARTICLE; AND
- 11 (6) AN ACTION AGAINST THE PROPERTY OF THE ALLEGED DISABLED 12 PERSON.
- 13 **(B)** AN AUTOMATIC STAY UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL 14 REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL:
- 15 (1) THE COURT APPOINTS A TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT GUARDIAN
 16 OF THE PROPERTY OF THE DISABLED PERSON, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST; OR
- 17 (2) THE COURT DENIES THE PETITION.
- 18 (C) (1) TO EFFECTUATE SERVICE OF PROCESS ON AN ALLEGED DISABLED
 19 PERSON FOR AN ACTION STAYED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE
 20 TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT GUARDIAN OF THE PROPERTY OF THE DISABLED
 21 PERSON, AS APPROPRIATE, MUST BE SERVED.
- 22 (2) AN ACTION STAYED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE DISMISSED IF 23 SERVICE OF PROCESS IS NOT EFFECTUATED IN COMPLIANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) 24 OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
