- FOR the purpose of expanding eligibility for the Maryland Dent–Care Program to include part–time dentists and dental hygienists who are practicing under a general or limited license; authorizing the Office of Student Financial Assistance within the Maryland Higher Education Commission, in collaboration with the Maryland Department of Health, to establish prorated loan repayment assistance for part–time dentists and dental hygienists; and generally relating to eligibility for the Maryland Dent–Care Program.

17 18	Each recipient of a Higher Education Loan Assistance Grant under this subtitle may hold the grant for up to 3 years if the recipient:
