- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 15 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 16 INDICATED.
- 17 (2) "POINT-OF-SALE SYSTEM" MEANS A DIGITAL DEVICE USED TO 18 PROCESS ELECTRONIC TRANSACTIONS FOR THE PURCHASE OF GOODS OR SERVICES.
