- 3 (A) **(1)** IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 4 INDICATED.
- "POINT-OF-SALE SYSTEM" MEANS A DIGITAL DEVICE USED TO 5 PROCESS ELECTRONIC TRANSACTIONS FOR THE PURCHASE OF GOODS OR SERVICES. 6
- 7 "TIP" MEANS AN ADDITIONAL PAYMENT VOLUNTARILY MADE BY A 8 CUSTOMER IN RECOGNITION OF SERVICE PROVIDED TO THE CUSTOMER.
- 9 BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2025, EACH BUSINESS LICENSED BY THE 10 DEPARTMENT THAT USES A POINT-OF-SALE SYSTEM THAT DURING A TRANSACTION AUTOMATICALLY DISPLAYS A SCREEN PROMPTING THE CUSTOMER TO SELECT AN 11 12AMOUNT FOR A TIP SHALL CONSPICUOUSLY DISPLAY ON THE SAME SCREEN:
- 13 **(1)** Information disclosing to whom the tip will be 14 ALLOCATED; AND
- 15 **(2)** A TIP AMOUNT SET AT ZERO BY DEFAULT.
- A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL 16 17 PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 A DISCLOSURE UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO THE RECORD-KEEPING REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 3-424 OF 18 THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE. 19
- 20 THE DEPARTMENT DIVISION OF CONSUMER PROTECTION SHALL 21ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THIS SECTION.
- 22**(E)** A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS:
- 23AN UNFAIR, ABUSIVE, OR DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE WITHIN **(1)** 24THE MEANING OF TITLE 13 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND
- 25**(2)** SUBJECT TO THE ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTY PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN TITLE 13 OF THIS ARTICLE. 26
- 27SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 October 1, 2024.
