SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 1 2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 **Article – Transportation** 4 13-402. 5 Except as otherwise provided in this section or elsewhere in the (a) (1) 6 Maryland Vehicle Law, each motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer driven on 7 a highway shall be registered under this subtitle. A vehicle operated in connection with maritime commerce exclusively

within any terminal owned or leased by the Maryland Port Administration;
