Education - Open-Source Phonics Matching Grant Program - Establishment (Open-Source Phonics Matching Grant Program Act)

FOR the purpose of establishing the Open-Source Phonics Matching Grant Program within

 Program; authorizing certain organizations to apply for grants from the Program;

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 **7–135.**

17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 18 INDICATED.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

<u>Underlining</u> indicates amendments to bill.

Strike out indicates matter stricken from the bill by amendment or deleted from the law by amendment.



1 (2) "OPEN-SOURCE" MEANS MATERIAL WITH EITHER FREELY 2 OBTAINABLE SOURCE CODE, A LICENSE FOR MODIFICATION, OR PERMISSION FOR 3 FREE DISTRIBUTION.

4 (3) "OPEN-SOURCE PHONICS ORGANIZATION" MEANS A NONPROFIT 5 ORGANIZATION OR PUBLIC LIBRARY THAT PRODUCES OR DISTRIBUTES FREE, 6 OPEN-SOURCE PHONICS MATERIALS IN THE STATE.

7 (4) "PHONICS" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 4–136 OF THIS 8 ARTICLE.

9 (5) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE OPEN-SOURCE PHONICS MATCHING 10 GRANT PROGRAM.

11 (B) THERE IS AN OPEN-SOURCE PHONICS MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM IN 12 THE DEPARTMENT.

13 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDS TO 14 OPEN-SOURCE PHONICS ORGANIZATIONS TO PROVIDE FREE, OPEN-SOURCE 15 PHONICS LEARNING MATERIALS TO BE USED BY ADULTS TO TUTOR STUDENTS IN 16 THE STATE.

17 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.

18 **(E) (1)** AN OPEN-SOURCE PHONICS ORGANIZATION MAY SUBMIT AN 19 APPLICATION FOR A GRANT ON THE FORM THAT THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES.

20 (2) AN APPLICATION FOR A GRANT SHALL INCLUDE A PLAN TO 21 ENSURE THAT THE OPEN-SOURCE PHONICS ORGANIZATION IS ABLE TO PROVIDE 22 FREE, OPEN-SOURCE PHONICS LEARNING MATERIALS TO ENABLE ADULTS TO 23 TUTOR STUDENTS IN THE STATE.

24(3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DISBURSE GRANTS TO OPEN-SOURCE25PHONICS ORGANIZATIONS.

26 (F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

(1) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2025, AND EVERY OTHER YEAR
THEREAFTER, REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE EFFECTIVENESS OF
THE PROGRAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT
ARTICLE; AND

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1(2)COLLECT STATISTICS AND OTHER INFORMATION NECESSARY FOR2THIS PURPOSE.

3 (G) FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE 4 ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$150,000 TO THE PROGRAM.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2024.
