15 (a) An individual may not drive a school vehicle on any highway in this State 16 unless the individual:

17 (1) Passes an appropriate medical examination BEFORE EMPLOYMENT
 18 AND ONCE DURING EACH 2 YEARS OF EMPLOYMENT; and

19 (2) For driving a school bus, has been issued a commercial driver's license 20 endorsed school bus.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 22 1, 2024.
