4 FOR the purpose of ~~establishing that certain records requested by and submitted to the~~
5 ~~Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission are not confidential and~~
6 ~~are subject to certain disclosure requirements~~ requiring the Baltimore County School
7 Board Nominating Commission to publish the names of the candidates for
8 appointment to the Baltimore County Board of Education on the Commission’s
9 website before interviewing the candidates; requiring certain meetings of the
10 Commission to be public; requiring certain meetings of the Commission to be held
11 without the public in attendance and recorded, and for the recording to be provided,
12 on request, within a certain period of time for public inspection; and generally
13 relating to records and meetings of the Baltimore County School Board Nominating
14 Commission.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Education**

2 (a) (1) There is a Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission.

3 (2) The purpose of the Commission is to select nominees to be
4 recommended to the Governor as qualified candidates for appointment to the Baltimore
5 County Board of Education.

6 (3) (i) The Commission shall hold at least three public hearings, each
7 in a different councilmanic district, on the selection of multiple nominees before
8 recommending to the Governor nominees for appointment to the county board.

9 (ii) For a single vacancy on the county board, the Commission shall
10 hold public meetings in the following manner on the selection of a nominee before
11 recommending to the Governor the nominee for appointment to the county board:

12 1. For a vacancy in a councilmanic district, at least one public
13 meeting in that councilmanic district; or

14 2. For a vacancy for a member appointed at large, at least
15 one public meeting at the county board administrative offices.

16 (iii) The Commission shall make publicly available on its website:

17 1. Live video streaming of each public meeting; and

18 2. A complete and unedited archived video recording of each
19 public meeting for which live streaming was made available under item 1 of this
20 subparagraph.

29 PARAGRAPH, A MEETING OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC IF IT
30 INVOLVES AN INTERVIEW OF, DELIBERATION ABOUT, OR ACTION ON A CANDIDATE
31 FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE COUNTY BOARD.

32 (II) 1. A MEETING OF THE COMMISSION THAT INVOLVES AN
33 INTERVIEW OF OR A DELIBERATION ABOUT A CANDIDATE FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE

1 COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE HELD WITHOUT THE PUBLIC IN ATTENDANCE AND THE
2 MEETING SHALL BE RECORDED.

3 2. THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF A
4 MEETING RECORDING FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION WITHIN 48 HOURS AFTER
5 RECEIVING A REQUEST FOR THE RECORDING.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
7 1, 2024.
