CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

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Health Occupations - Private Dental Offices - Infection Control

- FOR the purpose of requiring each owner of a private dental office to designate a licensed 4 dentist to be the supervising dentist for the private dental office; requiring a supervising dentist to complete the registration required by the State Board of 6 Dental Examiners and be responsible for all infection control activities within the private dental office; establishing a certain limit on the number of private dental offices that a supervising dentist may supervise; requiring the owner of a private dental office to designate an interim supervising dentist under certain 10 circumstances; authorizing the Board to charge a certain registration fee; and generally relating to infection control in private dental offices.
