14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
16	Article – Education
17	7–439.
18 19	(a) In this section, "nonpublic school" means a noncollegiate educational institution that:
20 21	(1) Holds a certificate of approval from the State Board under \S 2–206(e) of this article; and
22 23	(2) Participates in the Nonpublic Schools Textbook and Technology Grants Program.



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1 (b) The State Board and each nonpublic school in the State shall develop (1) 2 and implement a program of age-appropriate education on the awareness and prevention 3 of sexual abuse and assault. (2)The program required under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall [be]: 4 5 (i) [Taught] BE TAUGHT by a teacher who is trained to provide 6 instruction on the awareness and prevention of sexual abuse and assault; [and] 7 (ii) [Incorporated] BE INCORPORATED into the health curriculum 8 of each county board and each nonpublic school; AND 9 (III) INCLUDE, FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 6 THROUGH 8, 10 MATERIAL PROMOTING THE AWARENESS AND PREVENTION OF HUMAN AND SEX 11 TRAFFICKING. 12 (c) The State Board shall adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of this 13 section. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 14
