- 17 (D) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR FOR

- 19 (1) IF THE LICENSE HOLDER OFFERS FOOD ON THE PREMISES AT ALL
- 20 TIMES WHEN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE BEING SOLD; AND
- 21 (2) DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH §

- 23 (E) (1) THE LICENSE HOLDER'S ANNUAL GROSS SALES FROM:
- 24 (I) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY NOT EXCEED 35% OF THE
- 25 ANNUAL GROSS SALES OF THE GOLF SIMULATOR FACILITY;
- 26 (II) GOLF SIMULATOR BAY RENTAL FEES SHALL BE AT LEAST
- 27 50% OF THE ANNUAL GROSS SALES OF THE GOLF SIMULATOR FACILITY; AND
- 28 (III) FOOD SHALL BE AT LEAST 15% OF THE ANNUAL GROSS
