l AN ACT	concerning
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## Apprenticeships in Licensed Occupations Act of 2024

3 FOR the purpose of requiring professional and occupational regulatory boards to issue 4 licenses, certifications, and registrations to individuals who complete an 5 apprenticeship program that is established under certain provisions of this Act, pass 6 a certain examination, and pay a certain fee; authorizing the Maryland Department 7 of Labor to develop a standard apprenticeship program for a licensed occupation or 8 profession; requiring the Department to establish a workgroup to establish 9 group-sponsored apprenticeships in each occupation or profession for which a standard apprenticeship program is established; and generally relating to 10 11 occupational and professional apprenticeships.

- 4 BOARD MAY REQUIRE A FEE FOR AN APPRENTICE TO OBTAIN A LICENSE ONLY IF THE
- BOARD REQUIRES ALL APPLICANTS FOR LICENSURE TO PAY A FEE. 5

- 27 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
- 28 enacted.
