BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings** 2-315.(b) The Sheriff of Anne Arundel County shall receive an annual salary of: (1) **(I)** \$128,657 for calendar year 2014; and [(2)] (II) \$133,000 for calendar year 2015 [and each subsequent calendar year] THROUGH CALENDAR YEAR 2024.
