19 20	(I) A DIETARY SUPPLEMENT, AS DEFINED IN 21 U.S.C. § 321; OR
21 22 23	(II) A DRUG, AS DEFINED IN 21 U.S.C. § 321, FOR WHICH A PRESCRIPTION IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE FEDERAL FOOD, DRUG, AND COSMETIC ACT.
