Vehicle Laws - Damaged, Obscured, or Modified Registration Plates

FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to offer during the registration renewal process to replace certain vehicle registration plates that are more than a certain age; altering the prohibition against obscuring or modifying a vehicle registration plate by prohibiting such activity in a manner that may prevent identification; altering the penalty and points assessment for obscuring or modifying a vehicle registration plate; and generally relating to damaged, obscured, or modified vehicle registration plates.
