SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "BOOST PROGRAM" MEANS THE BROADENING 17 OPTIONS AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS TODAY PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES 18 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF 19 AGRICULTURE FREE OR REDUCED PRICE LUNCH PROGRAM TO ATTEND ELIGIBLE 20 NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS.

HOUSE BILL 791

1 (B) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL A 2 GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION IN THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS FOR THE BOOST 3 PROGRAM:

- 4 (1) \$10,000,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026;
- 5 (2) \$12,000,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027;
- 6 (3) \$14,000,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2028; AND
- 7 (4) \$16,000,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2029 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR 8 THEREAFTER.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2024.
