- 4 FOR the purpose of providing that a member of a certain board, committee, commission, $\mathbf{5}$ task force, or workgroup created by State law may be removed or suspended for 6 misconduct, incompetence, neglect of duties, or other good cause by the individual or 7 entity that appointed the member under certain circumstances; requiring certain 8 procedures to be followed before a certain member may be removed or suspended; 9 providing that this Act is not intended to limit certain rights of members; and generally relating to the removal or suspension of members of boards, committees, 10 commissions, task forces, and workgroups. 11

NOTHING IN THIS SECTION IS INTENDED TO LIMIT THE RIGHTS OF A 28**(E)** MEMBER TO EXPRESS THE MEMBER'S VIEWS ON MATTERS OF PUBLIC CONCERN TO 29THE FULLEST EXTENT PROTECTED FOR A PUBLIC OFFICIAL, AS DEFINED IN § 5-101 30 OF THE GENERAL PROVISIONS ARTICLE, BY THE U.S. CONSTITUTION OR BY THE 3132MARYLAND CONSTITUTION.
