2 State Board of Nursing – Technology Upgrade Study 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Department of Health to study options for upgrading the licensing and telephone systems used by the State Board of Nursing; 4 5 and generally relating to a technology upgrade study for the State Board of Nursing. 6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 7 That the Maryland Department of Health shall: 8 study options for upgrading the licensing system used by the State 9 Board of Nursing to allow: 10 (i) all initial applications and renewal applications for licenses and certifications issued by the Board to be processed online; and 11 12 (ii) the status of an application to be tracked by the applicant using 13 the Internet; 14 (2) study options for upgrading the telephone system used by the State Board of Nursing to allow: 15 16 (i) all calls to be routed to the appropriate Board unit; 17 voice messages to be left outside of office hours; and (ii) 18 (iii) Board staff to track call wait times; 19 on or before October 1, 2024, submit a report to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee, in accordance 20 21 with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, that includes an action plan for:

- 1 (i) the acquisition of a new electronic licensing system and a new 2 telephone system for the State Board of Nursing; and
- 3 (ii) the Board to appropriately staff the telephone system; and
 - (4) on or before March 1, 2025, submit a report to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, on the status of the acquisition of a new electronic licensing system and new telephone system for the State Board of Nursing.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 9 $\,$ 1, 2024.
