The employer [or], its insurer, OR THE UNINSURED EMPLOYERS' FUND shall begin paying compensation to the covered employee within 15 days after the later of the date:

  - (2) payment of an award is due.

8 (a) If the Commission finds that an employer [or], its insurer, OR THE 9 UNINSURED EMPLOYERS' FUND has failed, without good cause, to begin paying an 10 award within 15 days after the later of the date that the award is issued or the date that 11 payment of the award is due, the Commission shall assess against the employer [or], its 12 insurer, OR THE UNINSURED EMPLOYERS' FUND, a fine not exceeding 20% of the 13 amount of the payment.

14 (b) If the Commission finds that an employer [or], its insurer, OR THE 15 UNINSURED EMPLOYERS' FUND has failed, without good cause, to begin paying an 16 award within 30 days after the later of the date that the award is issued or the date that 17 payment of the award is due, the Commission shall assess against the employer [or], its 18 insurer, OR THE UNINSURED EMPLOYERS' FUND, a fine not exceeding 40% of the 19 amount of the payment.

20 (c) The Commission shall order the employer [or], insurer, OR THE UNINSURED
 21 EMPLOYERS' FUND to pay a fine assessed under this section to the covered employee.

(1) an order of the Commission requiring payment of compensation; or

25 (2) an order or supplemental order of the Commission requiring the 26 provision of medical treatment.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to 28 apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or 29 application to any claim arising before the effective date of this Act.

30 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 October 1, 2024.
