Health Insurance – Epinephrine Injectors – Limits on Cost Sharing (Epinephrine Cost Reduction Act of 2024)

 pay in copayments, coinsurance, and deductibles for a covered prescription
 epinephrine injector; and generally relating to health insurance coverage for

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 19 INDICATED.

20 (2) (I) "EPINEPHRINE INJECTOR" MEANS A PORTABLE, 21 DISPOSABLE DRUG DELIVERY DEVICE THAT CONTAINS A PREMEASURED SINGLE 22 DOSE OF EPINEPHRINE THAT IS USED TO TREAT ANAPHYLAXIS IN AN EMERGENCY 23 SITUATION.

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29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all 30 policies, contracts, and health benefit plans issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or 31 after January 1, 2025.

32 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 33 January 1, 2025.
