SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

16 (a) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the County Commissioners 17 of Somerset County may enter into a lease purchase agreement and related financing 18 agreements to obtain property for a public purpose in the county.
