12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13	That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
14	Article – Environment
15	9–2302.
16	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "SALT" MEANS SODIUM CHLORIDE, CALCIUM
17	CHLORIDE, MAGNESIUM CHLORIDE, OR ANY OTHER SUBSTANCE THAT CONTAINS
18	CHLORIDE AND IS USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEICING OR ANTI-ICING.
19	(B) (1) EACH STATE AGENCY, COUNTY, AND MUNICIPALITY SHALL:
20	(I) MAINTAIN RECORDS OF EACH HIGHWAY SALT APPLICATION
21	MADE FOR THE WINTER WEATHER SEASON; AND



1	(II) SUBMIT BY JULY 1 EACH YEAR A REPORT TO THE
2	DEPARTMENT ON ITS ANNUAL HIGHWAY SALT APPLICATION FOR THE PREVIOUS
3	WINTER SEASON, INCLUDING:

- 4 1. THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF SALT APPLIED; AND
- 5 2. The amount of salt applied per lane mile 6 under its jurisdiction.
- 7 (2) IN DETERMINING THE AMOUNTS OF SALT APPLIED, A STATE 8 AGENCY, COUNTY, AND MUNICIPALITY SHALL INCLUDE SALT APPLIED:
- 9 (I) AT SCHOOLS, INCLUDING INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER 10 EDUCATION, AND PUBLIC PARKS; AND
- 11 (II) BY PRIVATE CONTRACTORS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
