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1 (B) WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER A REGULATION ADOPTED BY THE U.S. 2 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO LOWER THE ACCEPTABLE DUST-LEAD 3 STANDARDS TAKES EFFECT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO 4 MAKE THE STATE DUST-LEAD STANDARDS CONSISTENT WITH THE FEDERAL 5 STANDARDS, INCLUDING THE STATE DUST-LEAD STANDARDS USED FOR THE 6 PURPOSES OF:

7 (1) ABATEMENT AND CLEARANCE INSPECTIONS FOR ABATEMENT 8 PROJECTS;

9 (2) SATISFYING THE RISK REDUCTION STANDARDS; AND

10(3)IDENTIFYING DUST-LEAD HAZARDS DURING AN ENVIRONMENTAL11INVESTIGATION.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 13 1, 2024.

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
