BY adding to Article - Education Section 7–118 Annotated Code of Maryland (2022 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education

3 4	(2) (I) "DEBT" MEANS ANY MONEY, OBLIGATION, CLAIM, OR SUM DUE OR OWED BY A STUDENT OR FORMER STUDENT TO A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL.
5 6	(II) "DEBT" DOES NOT INCLUDE THE FEE, IF ANY, CHARGED TO A STUDENT FOR THE ACTUAL COSTS OF PROVIDING A TRANSCRIPT.
7 8	(3) "Nonpublic school" means a nonpublic school in the State that participates in State-funded education programs.
9 10	(4) "STUDENT" INCLUDES CURRENT STUDENTS AND FORMER STUDENTS OF A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL.
